Yesterday I moved into my new home after having spent 16 weeks in the refuge, with my six year old son. If the refuge had not been in existence, our flight would have been much more desperate. Because there was a refuge in Llydebank, my son was able to attend his own school without the need to change to another.

The peace of mind offered to me by living in the refuge was astounding. There are no words to explain the feeling of peace of mind.

Please, on behalf of all women in impossible situations, ensure that the Llydebank Refuge remains open.
